
# BUT in February 2020, something changed. COVID-19 came to Singapore!






The COVID-19 virus is small and spreads easily.

Some people get so sick that they may die.




I feel scared sometimes when I think about COVID-19.

I cough or sneeze into my elbow or a tissue.




I keep my hands to myself and avoid touching my face.
