


INCONTINENTIA PIGMENTI



- A rare genetic condition which affects the skin, hair, teeth, eyes, bone and central nervous system.
- It is usually lethal in males.
- Affected individuals have skin with whorls of brown or white lines which may go through four distinct stages in their lifetime:
 - Initial blisters in the first few weeks of life
 - Rough warty pigmented lesions from a few months to the first year of life
 - Hyperpigmented whorls for a few years
 - Then hypopigmented whorls of lines on their skin
- No treatment is effective, other than symptomatic relief for the skin lesions.
- For other organ system involvement, relevant sub-specialist's management is required.
