It is with immense pride and deep reflection that we mark the centennial celebration of KK Women's and Children's Hospital (KKH) as a maternity hospital. This centennial is not only a celebration of our rich history but also a moment to honour the visionary spirit that has guided us through the decades. It is an opportunity to recognize the contributions of our staff, the support of our partners, and the trust of the community that has been with us every step of the way.

We have a long history to tell. Started as a general hospital in 1858, KKH became a dedicated maternity hospital in 1924. Over the next 100 years, KKH stands as a beacon of unwavering commitment to the health and well-being of women. In 1966, KKH made it to the Guinness Book of Records with the largest number of births in a single maternity hospital that year, an accolade that marked our leading role in maternal care. Over the years, KKH continues to be the largest maternity hospital in Singapore, bringing more than 10,000 new lives into this world every year, including the first IVF baby in Asia. This year, we celebrated the birth of the 1.6 millionth baby born at KKH. Another significant milestone was the incorporation of paediatric departments from Singapore General Hospital, Tan Tock Seng Hospital and Alexandra Hospital to transform KKH into a hospital for women and children in 1997. Today, KKH is a leading center of excellence in women, neonatal and pediatric care.

While the focus in the early years was on improving maternal and neonatal mortality rates, KKH has evolved into an academic medical centre of today, one that transforms care through research, innovation and education. With the impetus to optimize early human potential, we have established the SingHealth Duke-NUS Maternal and Child Health Research Institute (MCHRI) to translate research into implementation using a life-course approach. We made our first big stride with the launch of MCHRI's flagship programme, the Health Early Life Moment, Singapore (HELMS). We have also launched various signature programmes such as the Integrated Platform for Research in Advancing Metabolic Health Outcomes of Women and Children (IPRAMHO) and the Parenthood Genetic Disease Carrier Test (Predict) to screen couples who are at risk of having children with rare diseases,

This year's KKH Scientific Meeting, the KKH Maternity Centennial Scientific Meeting, promises an engaging programme with insights from international and local experts. We are honoured to have Mr Ong Ye Kung, Minister of Health, grace us with his presence as Guest of Honour. I would also like to thank Professor Tan Kok Hian and A/Professor Chua Mei Chien, chair and co-chair of the organizing committee as well as Prof Teoh Tiong Ghee and A/Professor Tan Lay Kok, chair and co-chair of the scientific committee.

As we celebrate this landmark event, we also look to the future with renewed vigor and optimism. The next century promises to bring new challenges and opportunities, and we remain committed to evolving with the times while staying true to the core values of compassion, integrity and collaboration.
