

Reading Development



Learning to read does not come naturally for children.

Learning to read does not develop naturally. It needs to be directly taught.

Children should not start learning the letter names and writing them in alphabetical sequence from a-z.

Children can start learning frequently occurring letters which they can associate with common objects or the letters in their own name.



Parents should read with their child at least 10-15mins everyday.

There are at least 75% of high-frequency words in the English Language.





Environmental print such as logos, labels, posters can be used to expose children in learning to read.

Story books & flashcards are not the only resources to teach a child to read.
