

## Specimens Requirement for Transfusion Reaction Investigation

Patient's age 10 years old and above:	Patient's age less than 10 years old:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Blood / Blood product pack(s) with intact infusion set placed individually in the customized Ziploc bag with kangaroo pouch (obtainable from MMD)</li> <li>• Completed 63170-Form-0128 – KKH Report of Reaction to Blood and Blood Components</li> <li>• One page of patient's sticky labels</li> </ul> <p><b>Post-I specimens</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One tube of 10 ml EDTA blood (for rechecking ABO, compatibility testing and DAT)</li> </ul> <p><b>Post-II specimen (to be taken 24hours after Post-1 specimens)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One tube of 10 ml EDTA blood (for rechecking ABO, compatibility testing and DAT)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Blood / Blood product pack(s) with intact infusion set placed individually in the customized Ziploc bag with kangaroo pouch (obtainable from MMD)</li> <li>• Completed 63170-Form-0128 – KKH Report of Reaction to Blood and Blood Components</li> <li>• One page of patient's sticky labels</li> </ul> <p><b>Post-I specimens</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One tube of 3 ml EDTA tube of at least 2 ml EDTA blood (for rechecking ABO, compatibility testing and DAT)</li> </ul> <p><b>Post-II specimen (to be taken 24hours after Post-1 specimens)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One tube of 3 ml EDTA tube of at least 2 ml EDTA blood (for rechecking ABO, compatibility testing and DAT)</li> </ul>
<p>* Please ensure that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Labels on all blood specimens are signed and the specimens labeled as Post I or Post II transfusion accordingly.</li> <li>2. Do not send specimens for transfusion reaction investigation if the reaction is <u>ONLY</u> urticaria. However, Doctor is required to complete the 63170-Form-0128 – KKH Report of Reaction to Blood and Blood Components and send it to Blood Bank. Blood Bank will fax the form to BSG for documentation and statistics collation purposes.</li> </ol>
