## Preparing for Surgery

## What is it?

When someone has a surgery, a special doctor called a surgeon helps to fix the part of the body that is hurting. There are some things you will need to know before the surgery. Read on to find out more!

## What happens before the surgery?



No food or drinks a few hours before the surgery so that your tummy can rest well during the surgery.





A small straw called the IV Plug will be put in your hand so that your body can drink medicine during the surgery.





You will need to change into a hospital gown to ensure you are free of germs and bacteria.



The nurse will bring you to the surgery room where you will lie on a bed. One person can follow you in (e.g. Mummy or Daddy).





The doctor will give you some sleepy gas using a mask that will help you fall asleep before the surgery.





Once you have fallen asleep, you will not feel anything. Mummy or Daddy will wait for you at the waiting area.





After the operation, you will rest in the recovery room for a while. The nurse will then bring you up back to your ward to rest.
