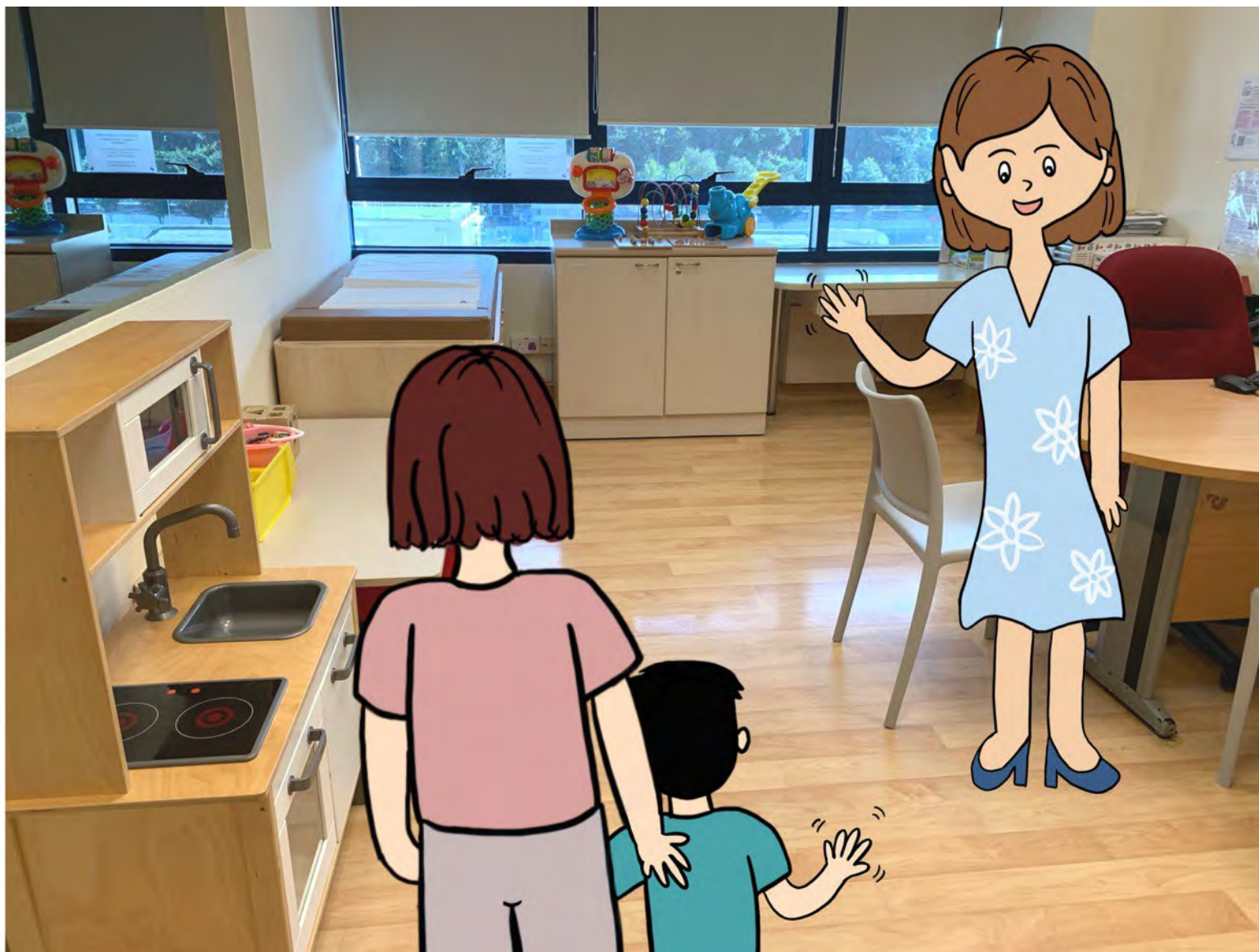




This is the machine that Mummy will use to let the doctor know we are here.

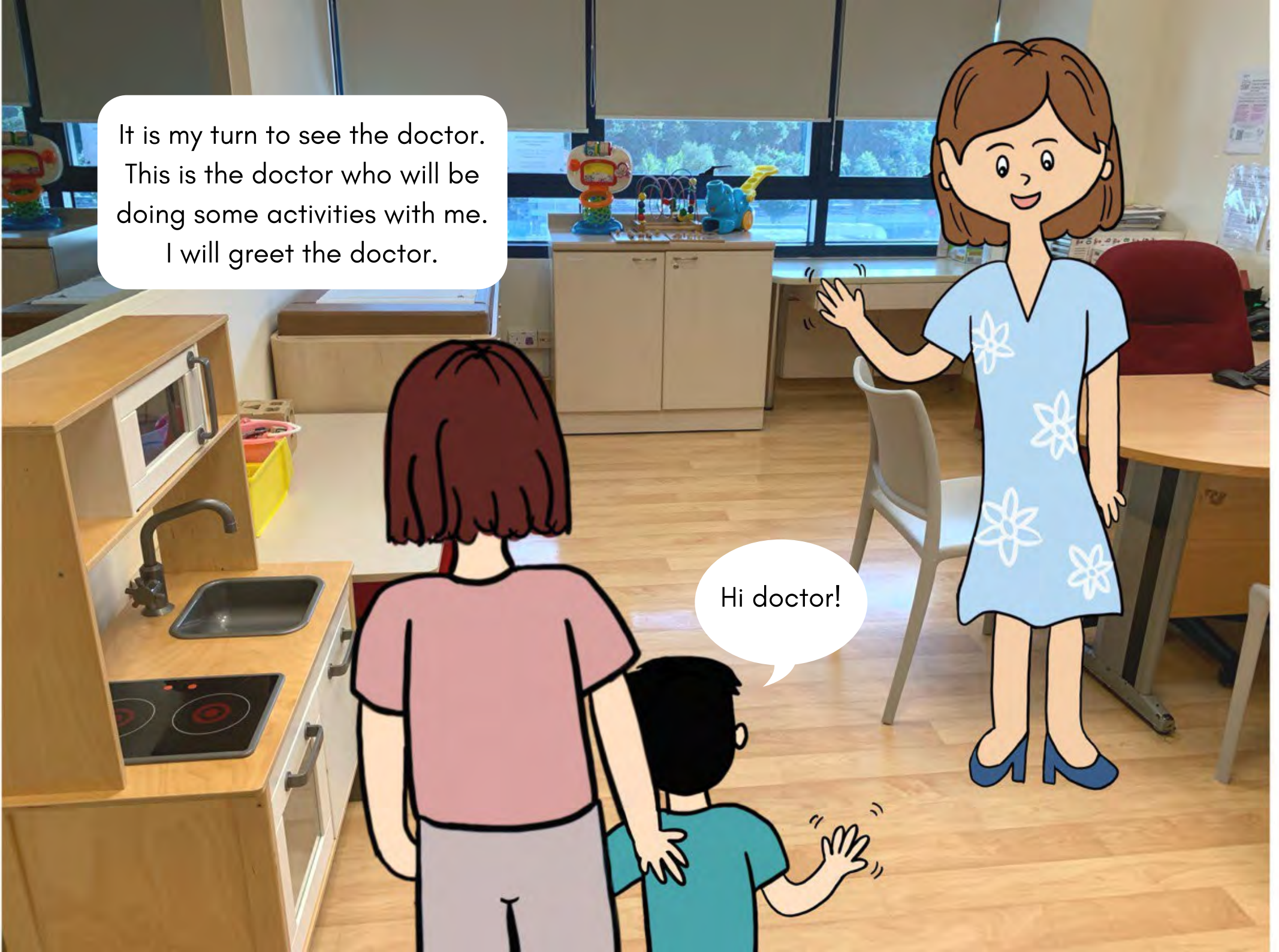
Stand upright...

The doctor will talk to me, ask me about myself and my school.



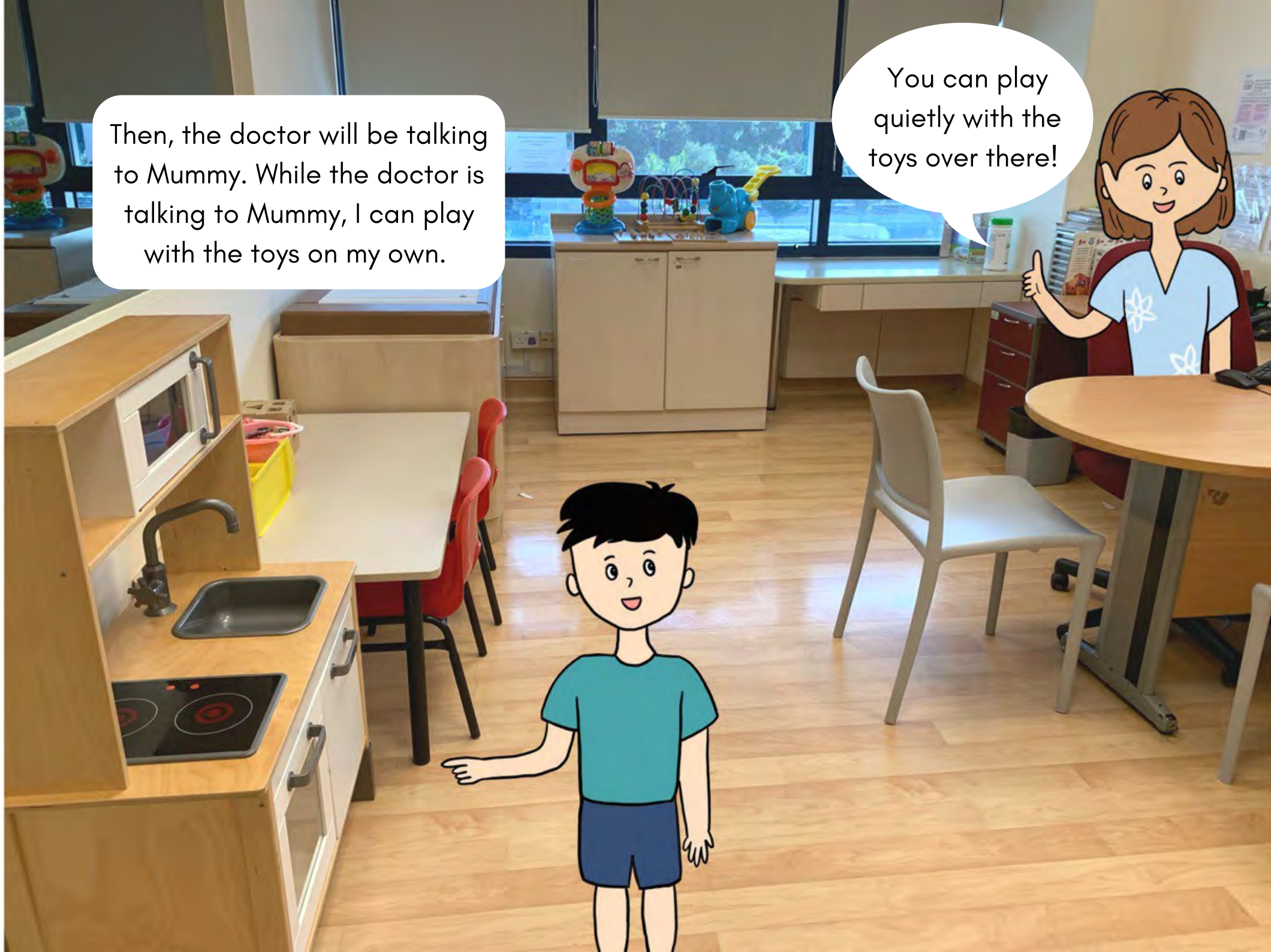
The doctor may also ask me to draw or write some things.
